Our capital campaign will culminate in May when each household will be invited to make a threeyear pledge above and beyond regular sustaining giving to support our capital rebuilding projects.

Our process will provide many opportunities for you to become involved through study, prayer, small-group meetings, fellowship events, and other activities. We need your help to be successful. In the next few months, you will be receiving information which will give you the full details of how we will support our rebuilding effort through our *"Build. Gather. Grow."* campaign. Watch for special publications and announcements.
