We have created a lively, supportive household for our daughter who lives in a single-family home in Berkeley. Two female housemates share the house with her, one younger, the other older, to provide companionship and help manage her household. Presently we are looking to fill the position for the younger housemate (20's to 40's) as a peer for our daughter: someone mature, flexible, and with a sense of fun. This part-time companionship role consists of 2 hours of service daily (14 hours/week), which equals the live-in benefit (so no rent). The position will be available mid-June, but the start date is flexible.

On some days of the week the 2 hours are needed in the morning; on the others in the evening, including preparing and sharing dinner. The preferred morning hours are from 9 and 11, and the evening hours from 5:30 to 7:30, with some flexibility. A predictable schedule is coordinated with the other housemate. We would like the housemate to spend most nights at the house.

Our daughter, bright, college-educated and artistic, lived independently in the past. After becoming ill in her 20's, she is now doing well, artistically engaged and independent in many ways. We, her parents, live nearby and spend some time together on most days.

The private home is located on a quiet North Berkeley street in a family neighborhood. Solano Ave. and Monterey Street shopping areas are nearby, as are North Berkeley BART and several bus lines. This part-time role is compatible with student status or employment outside the home up to 3/4 time, provided that work or studies fit and continue to fit the hours we need.
