Progress Report from Moe Wright

The construction of the new community building is continuing, despite the rain delays we have experienced since the beginning of the year. So far we have demolished the old building, and let some of the original foundation remain as a way to reduce costs, as well as to aid in shoring the perimeter of the footprint of the new building. Pilgrim Hall had a full basement level, which has mostly been filled in with imported, compacted base gravel. This step has allowed the excavation and forming of the foundations to proceed, even in wet weather.

All the sub-grade footings have been poured in two stages. The total concrete in place is a little over 200 cubic yards. Now the crew is working on the concrete stem walls, which will hold up the first floor. The building is designed to modern codes so the structure will contain both steel frames and wood shear panels. All of these pieces will be securely attached to the new foundation. If you look through the fence you will see a sea of bolts that will hold



our building safely in place.

The general contractor doing this work is Taizan Builders. Misael Taizan leads his small company of mostly Latino workers. They are doing the foundation work, the framing, and the finishes. In addition, they will also oversee the other trades with the help of Patrick Sallee, a seasoned construction manager.

The next big concrete pour will be in early March—and after that the wood frame begins, and we will all get to see the shape of the new building.
